Supply list

The following supplies may be purchased at any art supply store. Start with what you already have. If you are not sure where to start, we recommend visiting [Jerry's Artarama](#), [dickblick.com](#), or Amazon to begin your search. Click the items in blue to link out to the instructor-recommended supply.

General items

- Drawing boards (or sturdy foam core could work) - [Blick Sketch Pad Board - 15" x 16"](#)
- -Clear rulers (must be clear or translucent so they can see lines underneath) - buy in bulk on Amazon
- -Graphite set - at least 3 pencils per student (for example: HB, 4B, 8B)
- -Vine/Willow charcoal - soft or extra soft (1 half stick for each student)
- -Charcoal pencil set
- -[Prismacolor Premier Color Pencil set](#)
- -Sketch/Drawing paper
- -Bristol Paper (smooth)
- -Toned Paper- [Strathmore 400 Series Recycled Toned Sketch Wirebound Pads | BLICK Art Materials](#)
- -Plastic/Vinyl Erasers - work better and last longer than rubber erasers
- -Kneaded Erasers (normally I don't recommend a specific brand, but this is the exception: Faber-Castell w/ plastic case) - Amazon has packs of 4 - color doesn't matter

Paper sizes should be around 9'x12", though it's okay if it is a little smaller or bigger.

Optional Supplies

- Tortillons for blending
- Fine Pigment Liners (ink) - for lessons in mark-making
