

Supply list

Most of the following supplies may be purchased at any art supply store. Start with what you already have. Not all materials are needed for the first day. If you have any questions, please contact the instructor at oscar@oscarpetersonportraits.com. If you are not sure where to start, we recommend visiting Jerry's Artarama or dickblick.com to begin your search.

Paper - students can use white, colored, or both types

- Charcoal/Pastel pads available in 11 x 14", 12 x 16", or 18 x 24" sizes
- Assorted colors for graphite or charcoal, or individual sheets.

General items

- Plumb line: Make one using a piece of straight, dark thread tied to a nail or another small weighted
- Viewfinder: Make one of the cardboard from a shirt or the back of a legal pad. Make 2 "L" shapes, about 7" on the leg and 1.5" wide. Use 2 paper clips to attach.
- Knitting needle (a thin one #0,1, or 2) or bamboo skewer
- Single-edge razor blade or small utility knife with retractable blade (for sharpening pencils)
- Sandpaper
- black Binder/bankers clips
- Artist tape
- Erasers
- Kneaded eraser
- Pink pearl eraser
- Boards: Sketch board or foam board (large enough for 18 x 24"- or cut a little larger than paper size)
